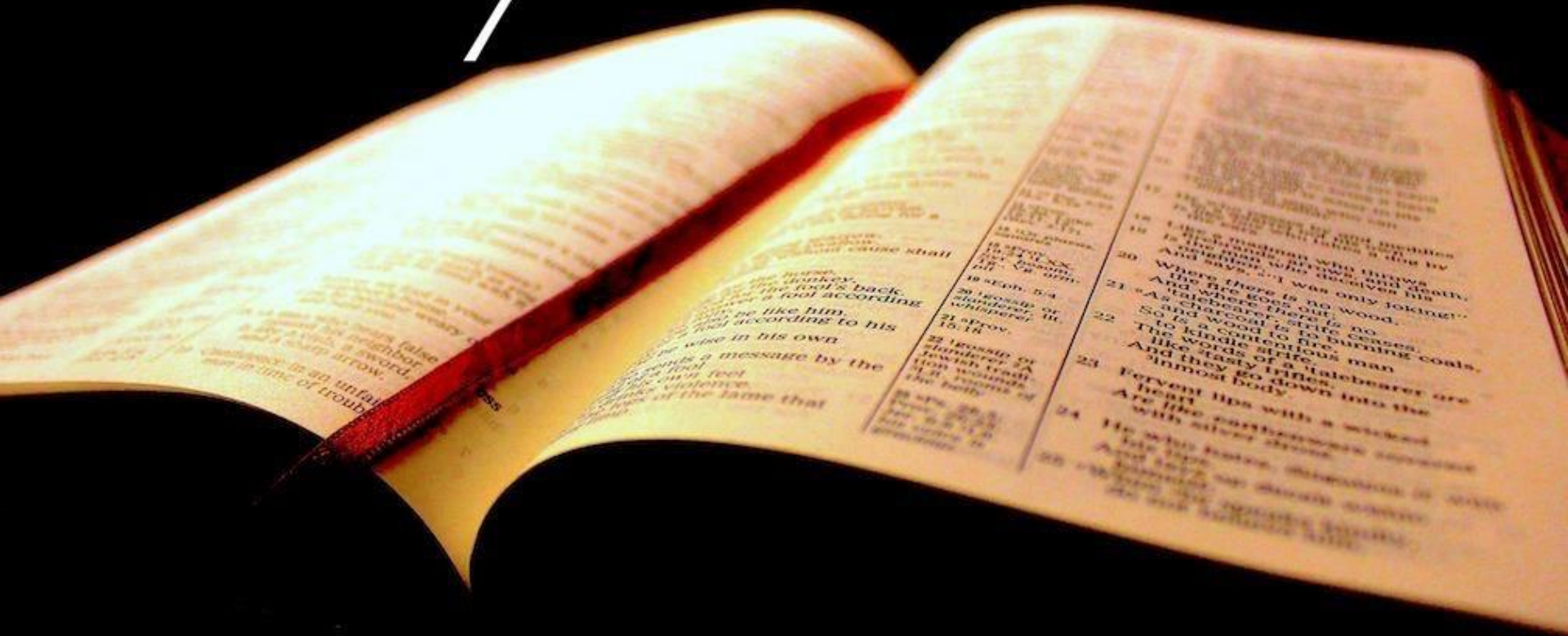

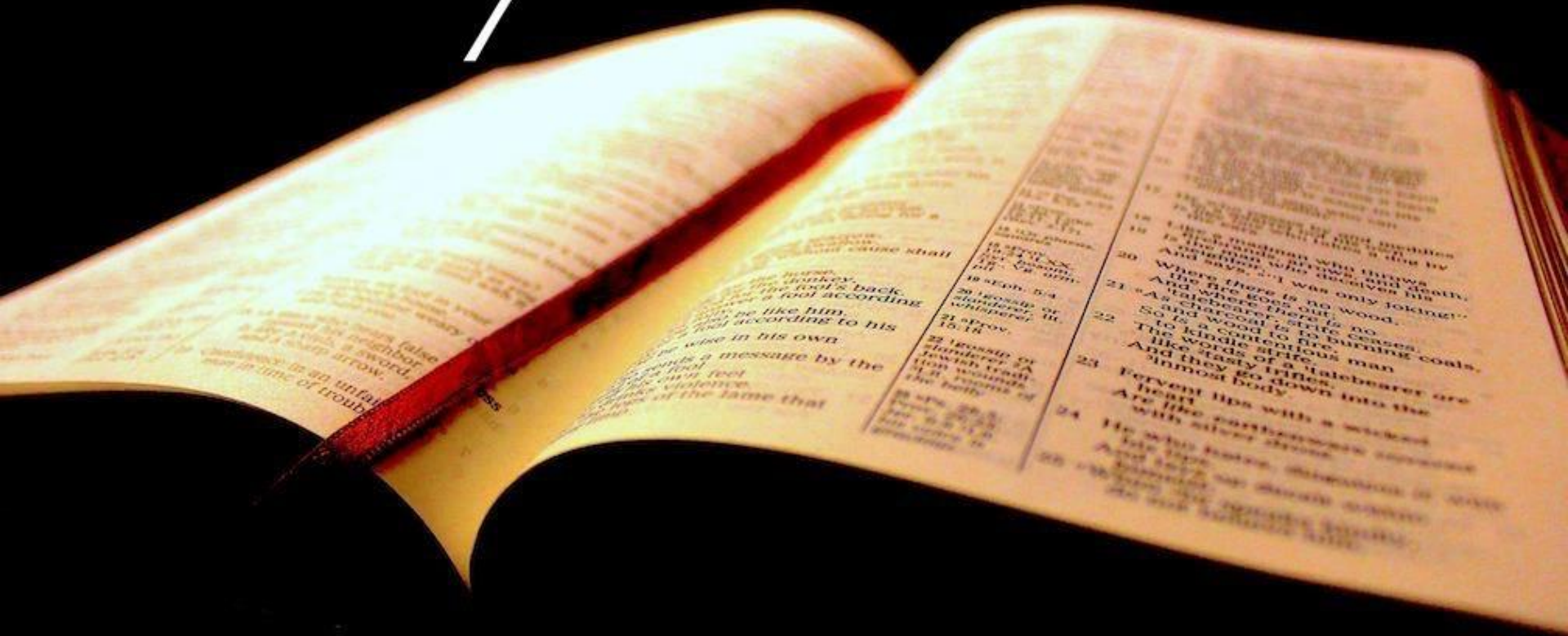

Scripture ALONE



German Luther scholar Bernhard Lohse says that although the Early and Medieval Church took for granted the authority of Scripture, the “principle of ‘Scripture alone’ was never advocated before Luther.” Lohse also notes that before Luther invoked the concept of sola Scriptura, the church had not addressed “the relationship between Scripture and tradition.”

We believe, teach, and confess that the only rule and norm according to which all teachings, together with ‹all› teachers, should be evaluated and judged are the prophetic and apostolic Scriptures of the Old and New Testament alone. ...

1. Scripture is the source and norm of all Biblical doctrine.

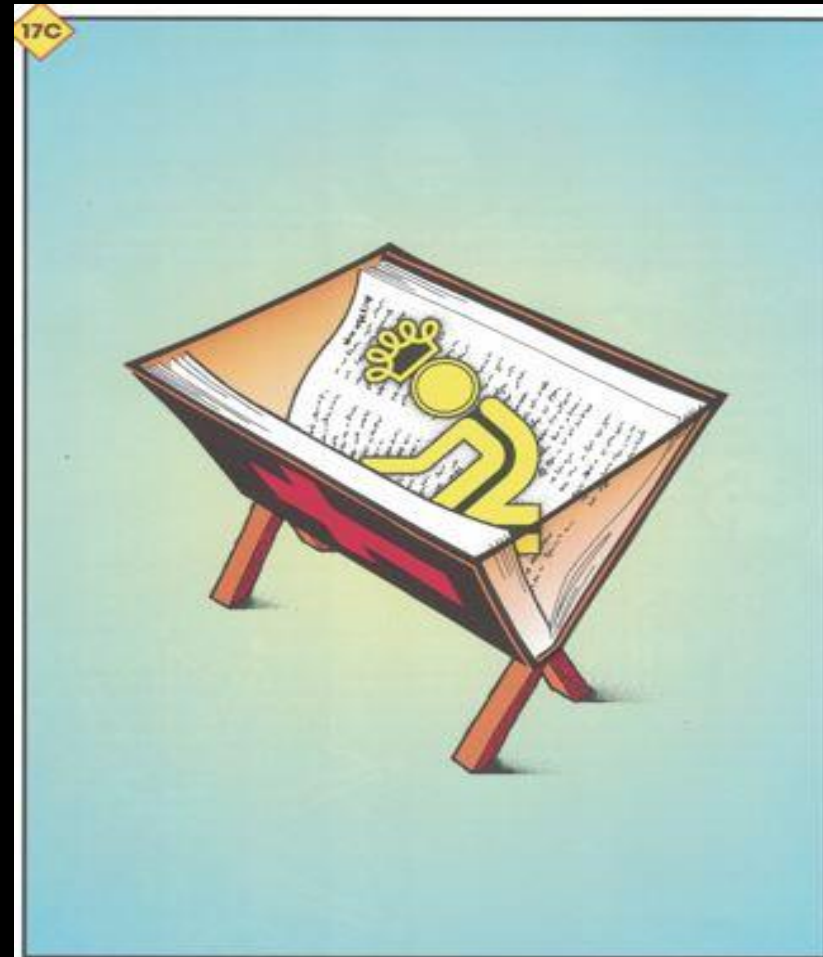
