

"I have hidden your Word in my heart..." Psalm 119:11

A little trivia Psalm 119 is the longest Psalm in the Bible and also the longest chapter, with 176 verses.

Do you know what the theme of that Psalm is? It's learning to love and apply God's Word in our lives.

There are 22 sections. Each section talks about one aspect of our spiritual relationship with God. Our verse today comes from the section that speaks of **how to keep out of trouble**:

"How can a young person (old people, too) keep their way pure?
By living according to your Word.
I seek You with all my heart:
Do not let me stray from Your commands."

The rest of this section tells us God's Word is VALUABLE ... we call it the **BIBLE**.

"I have hidden Your Word in my heart that I might not sin against You. Praise be to You, O Lord: teach me Your decrees.

With my lips I recount all the laws that come from Your mouth.

I rejoice in following Your statutes as one rejoices in great riches.

I meditate on Your precepts and consider Your ways.

I delight in Your decrees; I will not neglect Your Word."
